For the benefit of TAPE Members, TAPE Board of Directors, Director Steven Cabler proposed a change of the seminar schedule to include Saturday as a 6 hour session instead of the regular 4 hour. This would benefit those examiners that need to fulfill their required Continuing Education requirements, yet are unable to take a day off of work to attend on a weekday. President Clay Wood discussed this proposed change with all of the Board Members and Officers and the consensus was that this new schedule should be implemented as a trial at the October 2016 Seminar and was a success. Therefore, those examiners who are attending the TAPE seminar just to acquire their required six (6) hours for license renewal, just have to make the Friday or Saturday session. Those that need to acquire their required twenty (20) for JPCOT would attend the normal seminar as usual. As discussed, in order to compensate for the added time on Saturday, the seminar will begin on Thursday morning at 10 am, thus allowing morning travel time for those TAPE members who want to save one (1) night of hotel expense. The Saturday session would be planned to start at 8am and conclude at 3PM (allowing for lunch break)

Unlike our sister association Texas Association of Law Enforcement Polygraph Investigators, (TALEPI) most TAPE members are private examiners and have to absorb the cost of seminar dues, travel, hotel and food and we try to cater to the private examiner delivering adequate and cutting edge polygraph training for the time they are able to devote to any given seminar.
